### VIDEO: UBC fish expert urges action despite uncertainty in salmon run collapse

As the Cohen Commission -- a federal inquiry into the disappearance of 10 million Fraser River sockeye salmon -- gets underway in Vancouver this week, this video from the [Common Sense Canadian](#) is a timely reminder that, though we may not be able to stop the effects of global warming on aquatic ecosystems, we do have control over other factors that harm wild salmon.
